

## **Goldrea, Molycor acquire Empress molybdenum claims**

### **ACQUISITION OF MOLY CLAIMS**

Goldrea Resources Corp. and Molycor Gold Corp. have acquired claims covering the Empress molybdenum occurrence.

The claims are contiguous to the northwest boundary of the Crow Rea group of claims. The acquisition covers the old Empress molybdenum occurrence, which was drilled by Anaconda America Brass in 1969, and in 1980. The drilling consisted of 10,143 metres of diamond drilling and 3,428 metres of percussion drilling as reported by T.H. Carpenter, PGeo, in a report by Discovery Consultant's Ltd., dated Aug. 31, 1994.

Results of the diamond drilling are not available, but results from the percussion drilling (in six of the 42 holes) have values of up to 0.084 per cent molybdenum disulphide over 48.8 metres, starting at a depth of 9.15 metres as described in an assessment report by Luca Riccio, project geologist for Anaconda, dated May, 1982.

The claims are underlain by granodioritic and quartz monzonitic, phases of the Jurassic Okanagan batholith. Mineralization consists of fracture-controlled veinlets and disseminated molybdenite-pyrite in quartz-Kspar alteration zones of equigranular quartz monzonite and granodiorite.
